Publish via FTP

Select 'on BlogSpot.com' if you'd like to move your blog from your server to [blog*spot](#), Blogger's hosting service.

Blog URL hacx0redbyme

This is the URL of your weblog home page. For example: http://www.evhead.com

Server maor.pair.com

Enter the address of the server you connect to to edit your web site. Example: **ftp.yoursite.com**

Server Path public_html/plasticbag/

This is the directory on your file transfer server where you want to place your blog. Example: 'blogger'. If you want to make your blog your home page or place it elsewhere in your root directory, you might leave this field blank.

Note: This path must already exist. If it doesn't, create it with your file transfer program before publishing with Blogger.

Blog Filename index.shtml

This is the filename for your main blog page on your site. For example: 'weblog.html'. Or, if you are making it your home page, perhaps: 'index.html'. Note: This does not have to have an .html extension. In fact, if you use server-side scripting via ASP or PHP, for example, this filename might be default.asp or joebob.php. All your server-side processing will still happen. **WARNING:** If this file already exists on your server, it will be overwritten.

Server Username barbelit

This is the username you use to log into the file transfer server entered above. Enter it here if you don't want to be asked each time you publish.

Password

This is the password that goes along with the above username. Enter it here if you don't want to be asked each time you publish.

Ping Weblogs.com Yes

[Weblogs.com](#) is a blog update notification service that many individuals and services use to track blog changes.0 (Similar to the Recently Updated list on the Blogger home page.) Select Yes here if you'd like Blogger to notify weblogs.com whenever you publish. For more information, see [the FAQ](#).
